POSITION DESCRIPTION

Reconsidered Goods is a nonprofit creative reuse center that promotes environmental awareness, community engagement, and creative expression through reuse, education, and the arts.

The Education Intern position at Reconsidered Goods provides participants with the unique opportunity to assist with the operations of a hands-on arts education program in a non-profit creative reuse center. Through a combination of various learning experiences, projects, and collaborations, interns become integral members of our team. Interns are expected to participate in daily activities, contribute skills and ideas, and produce excellent work, all while preparing to become future leaders in the arts, nonprofit, and education fields.

Reconsidered Goods internships are unpaid. Interns are eligible for university credit, which must be identified and arranged by the intern and their university advisor.

QUALIFICATIONS

Education interns must:

- Be an undergraduate or graduate student
- Have experience and interest in working with children
- Have experience and interest in the arts and reuse as it applies to lifelong learning and wellbeing for children, teens, adults, and older adults
- Possess strong organizational skills and the ability to prioritize and manage projects
- Comfortable working independently as well as in a team environment on a variety of projects
- 10-20 hours a week
- Spring, Summer and Fall opportunities

SPECIFIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Reconsidered Goods Education Interns will directly assist with the planning, promotion, and facilitation of the following programs:

- Field Trips & Outreach Events: Education programs scheduled as requested in partnership with local schools, organizations, and festivals.
- Make-N-Take Lab, an onsite creative reuses makers lab
- Craft & Draft: Monthly drop-in craft gatherings in partnership with local breweries and bars.
